APRIL

- Baldacci, David. *The Fallen*. Amos Decker and his FBI colleague Alex Jamison are in Baronville visiting Alex's sister when they stumble on a horrific double murder scene. Then the next killing hits sickeningly close to home.
- Clark, Mary Higgins. *I've Got My Eyes on You*. After a party when her parents are away, eighteen-year-old Kerry Dowling is found fully dressed at the bottom of the family pool. Kerry's older sister Aline is determined to assist the Prosecutor's Office in finding the truth.
- Comey, James. *A Higher Loyalty*. Former FBI director James Comey shares his never-before-told experiences from some of the highest-stakes situations of his career in the past two decades of American government.
- Coulter, Catherine & Ellison, J.T. *The Sixth Day*. When several major political figures die, officials declare the deaths natural causes. Then the German Vice-Chancellor dies on the steps of 10 Downing Street, and a drone is spotted hovering over the scene. The truth is these deaths are assassinations and the Covert Eyes team investigates.
- Deaver, Jeffrey. *The Cutting Edge*. Lincoln Rhyme and Amelia Sachs return to New York City to confront a killer terrorizing couples at their happiest and most vulnerable.
- Nesbo, Jo. *Macbeth*. A crime novel set in 1970s Scotland, Inspector Macbeth heads the SWAT team in Capitol, determined to take down criminal gangs and to clean up the corrupt local government, a goal shared by Duncan, Capitol's upstanding police chief.
- Sandford, John. *Twisted Prey*. Lucas Davenport confronts an old nemesis, now more powerful than ever as a U.S. senator. A rich psychopath, Taryn Grant has found her seat on the Senate intelligence committee, and the contacts she's made from it, to be very...useful.
- Scottoline, Lisa. *After Anna*. Noah Alderman has remarried a wonderful woman, Maggie, and for the first time in a long time he and his son are happy. But their lives are turned upside down when Maggie's daughter moves in with them. Anna is a drop-dead gorgeous sixteen-year-old with a secret dark side.
- Thayer, Nancy. *A Nantucket Wedding*. A middle-aged widow meets a handsome CEO and is finally getting another chance at love, but she has her work cut out for her when she tries to blend two families of adult children.

- Cussler, Clive. *The Gray Ghost*. In 1906, a Rolls-Royce prototype known as the Gray Ghost vanishes from the streets of Manchester, England. An American detective named Isaac Bell prevents it from being lost forever. Marcus Peyton is the man wrongly blamed for the theft, and over a hundred years later, his grandson turns to Sam and Remi Fargo to help prove his grandfather's innocence.
- Evans, Richard Paul. *The Forgotten Road*. Everyone believes Chicago celebrity and motivational speaker, Charles James, was killed in a fiery plane crash. But thanks to a twist of fate he's very much alive and ready for a second chance at life.

- King, Stephen. *The Outsider*. When the corpse of a sexually assaulted 11-year-old boy is found, fingerprint evidence and eyewitness accounts implicate upstanding citizen Terry Maitland. He's got an alibi but Det. Ralph Anderson soon adds DNA evidence, and the investigation ratchets up to some scarily King-worthy puzzles.
- Koontz, Dean. *The Crooked Staircase*. Jane Hawk knows she may be living on borrowed time. But as long as she's breathing, she'll never cease her one-woman war against the conspiracy that threatens the freedom—and free will—of millions.
- McClain, Paula. *Love and Ruin*. A novel about Ernest Hemingway's passionate, stormy marriage to Martha Gellhorn—a fiercely independent, ambitious woman who would become one of the greatest war correspondents of the 20th Century.

- Backman, Fredrik. *Us Against You*. Backman revisits Beartown, where the cherished hockey team is slated for the dust heap. The players join a rival team in Hed, a new team forms (with a surprise coach), and a tense match with Hed ends in tragedy.
- Delinsky, Barbara. *Before and Again*. Mackenzie Cooper took her eyes off the road for just a moment but the resulting collision was enough to rob her not only of her beloved daughter but of her marriage, family, and friends—and even her privacy.
- Giffin, Emily. *All We Ever Wanted*. A devastating photo shared on social media has a community buzzing with scandal and blame. Nina Browning will be forced to choose between her family and her values.
- Hildebrand, Erin. *The Perfect Couple*. A bride-to-be is discovered dead in Nantucket Harbor just hours before the wedding ceremony and the entire wedding party is suspect.
