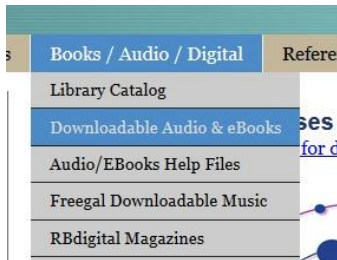




OverDrive Step by Step for the Kindle *

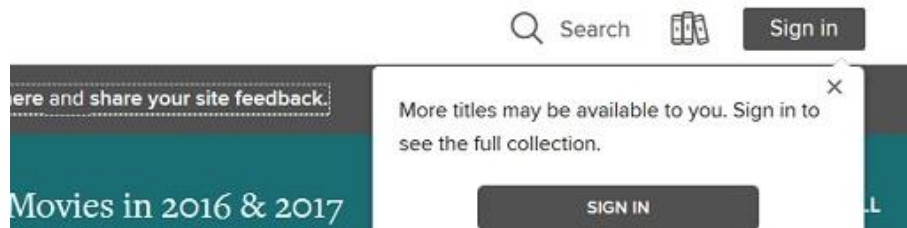
1. Go to the Pearl River library website and click on **Downloadable Audio & eBooks** here:



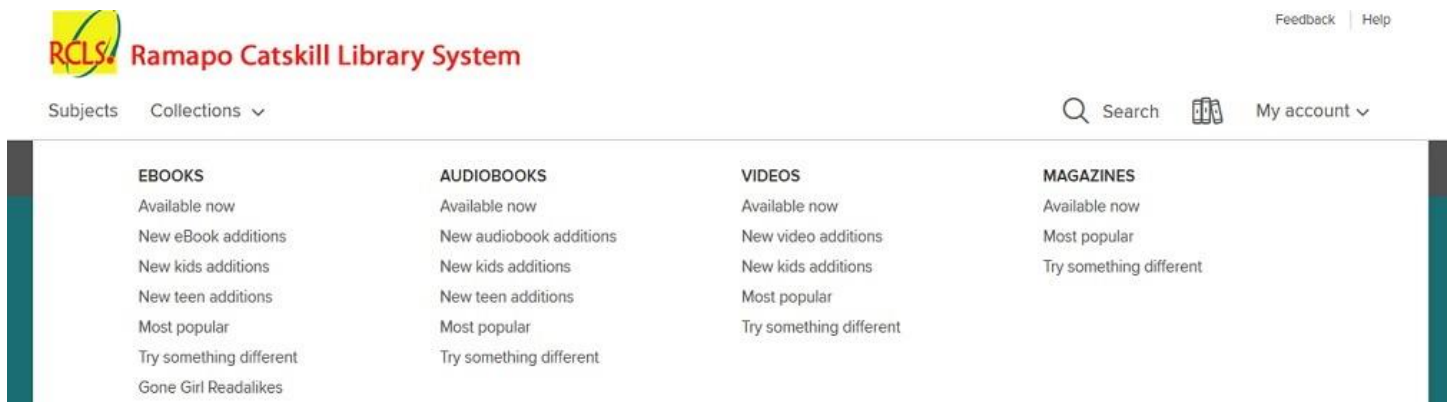

2. The Download Center looks the same for all libraries, but additional content is available to Pearl River Public Library cardholders. **Always SIGN IN first before searching for content.** Click on Sign In and log in with your library card barcode # and PIN (usually the last four digits of your phone number.)



3. You can search the database for a title by clicking on the magnifying glass icon on the top right or browse by collection or subject on the left.



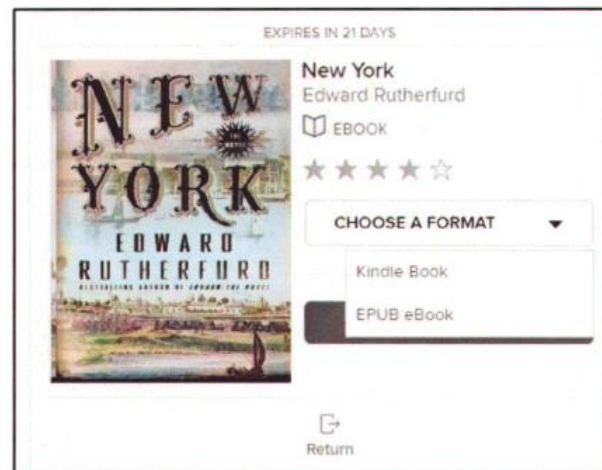

- When you find a title you would like to read, click on **Borrow** underneath the title to check it out. You will then see a banner that directs you to your **Loans** page. Click on **Loans** to download the book.

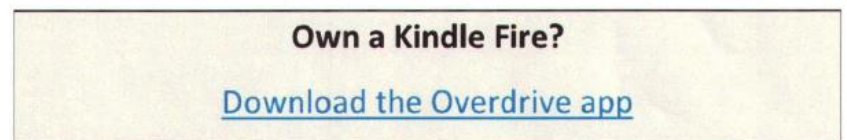
This title is now checked out to you until Thursday, December 8, 2016. See options for the title on your **Loans** page.

Titles which are already checked out will say **Place Hold** instead. Click to place a hold. You will receive an email when the title becomes available for download.

- On your **Loans** page, click on the down arrow beside **Choose a Format** and select **Kindle Book**. You will now be directed to Amazon.com.



- Log in to Amazon with your username and password for that site and click on **Get Library Book**. Your eBook will be downloaded to your Kindle the next time it connects to a wireless network.



DOWNLOAD THE FREE OVERDRIVE APP from your App store (Apple store or Google Play store). Search for *OverDrive* to find the app.
